logic diagrams (positive logic)



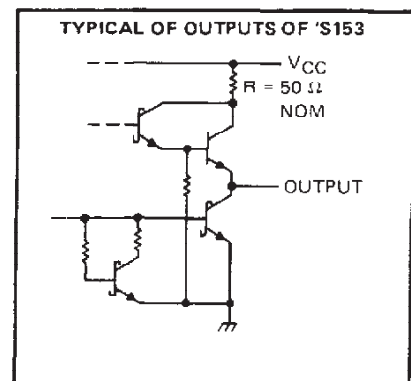
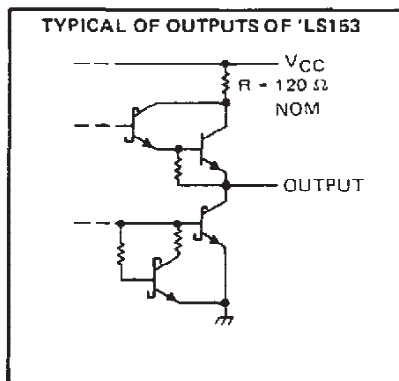
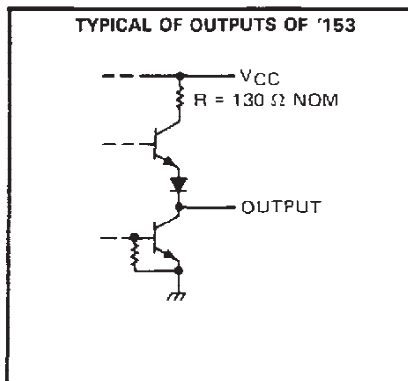
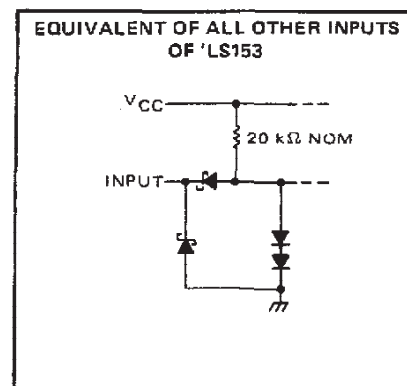
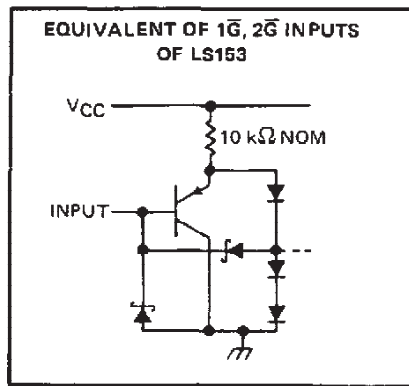
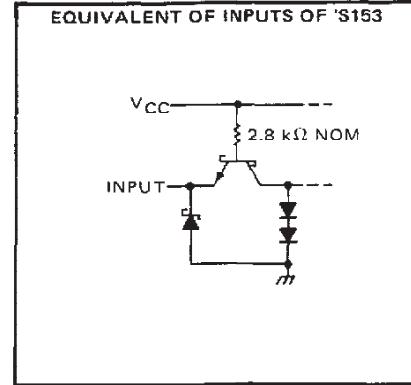
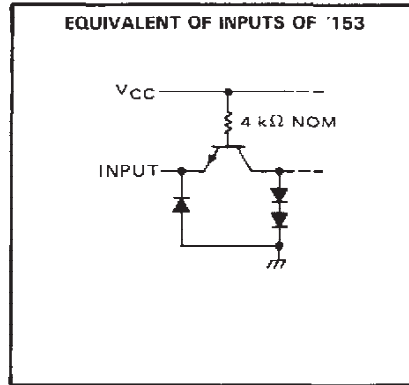
