DESCRIPTION

DG2016/DG2026 are monolithic **CMOS** single-pole/double-throw (SPDT) analog switchs. They are specifically designed for low-voltage, high bandwidth applications.

The DG2016/DG2026's on-resistance (3 Ω at 2.7 V), matching and flatness are guaranteed over the entire analog voltage range. Wide dynamic performance is achieved with better than - 80 dB for both cross-talk and off-isolation at 1 MHz.

Both SPDT's operate with independent control logic, conduct equally well in both directions and block signals up to the power supply level when off. Break-before-make is quaranteed.

With fast switching speeds, low on-resistance, high bandwidth, and low charge injection, the DG2016/DG2026 are ideally suited for audio and video switching with high linearity.

Built on Vishay Siliconix's low voltage CMOS technology, the DG2016/DG2026 contain an epitaxial layer which prevents latch-up

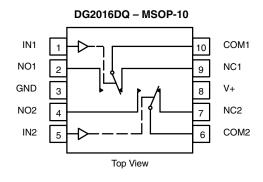

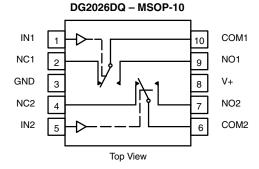

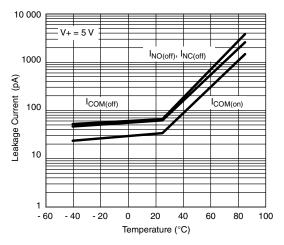

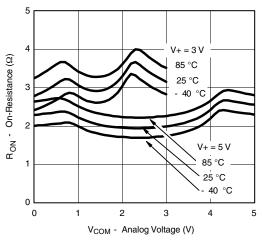
 $\rm R_{ON}$ vs. $\rm V_{COM}$ and Supply Voltage



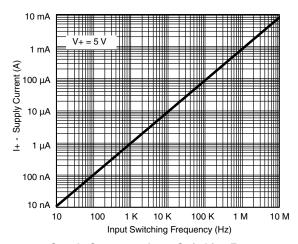
Supply Current vs. Temperature



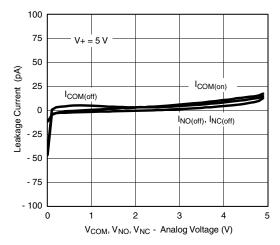
Leakage Current vs. Temperature



R_{ON} vs. Analog Voltage and Temperature



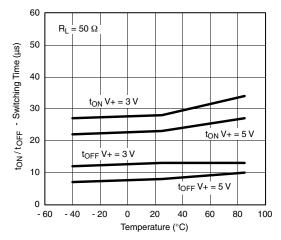
Supply Current vs. Input Switching Frequency



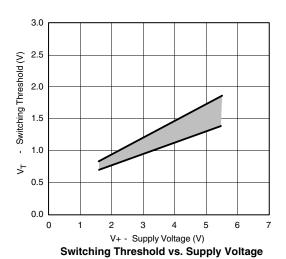
Leakage vs. Analog Voltage

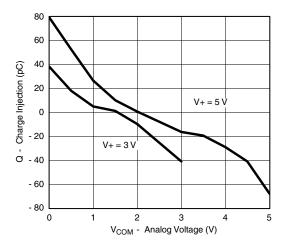


Switching Time vs. Temperature



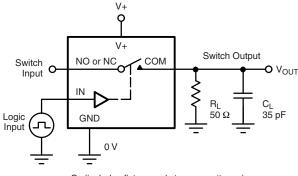

Insertion Loss, Off-Isolation Crosstalk vs. Frequency



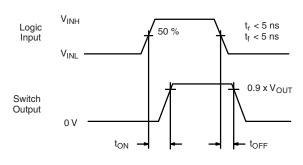
Charge Injection vs. Analog Voltage

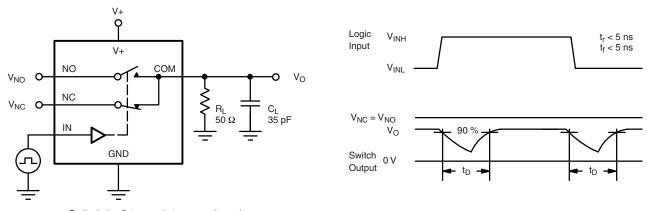

Figure 2. Break-Before-Make Interval

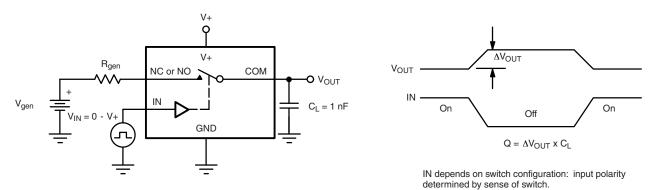


Figure 3. Charge Injection

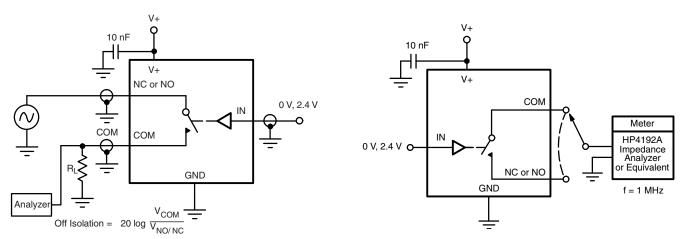


Figure 4. Off-Isolation
