

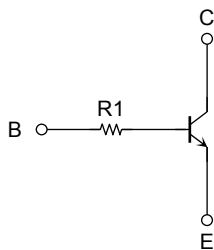

- Incorporating a bias resistor into a transistor reduces parts count. Reducing the parts count enables the manufacture of ever more compact equipment and lowers assembly cost.

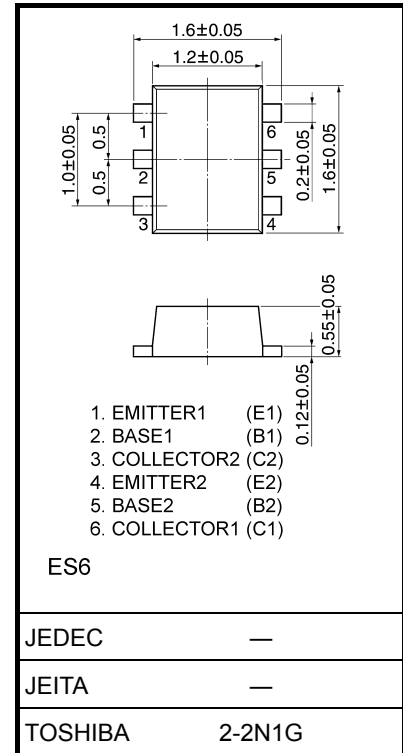

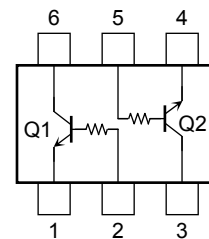

Equivalent Circuit (top view)

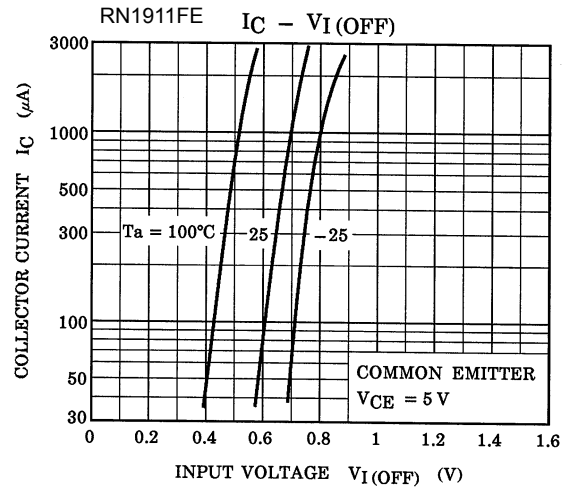
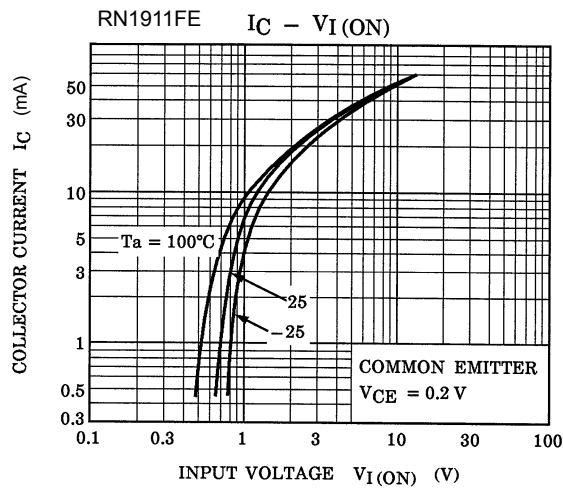
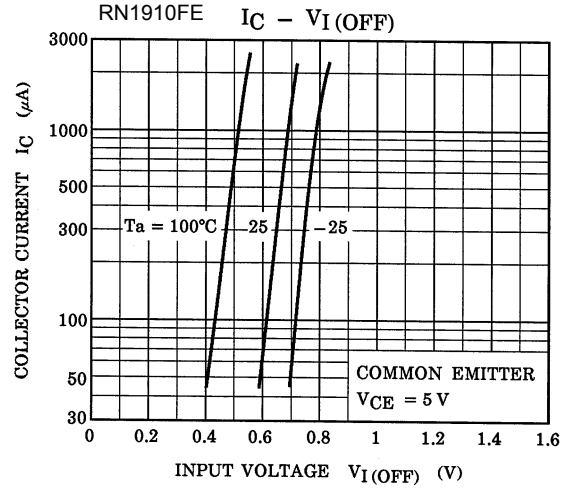
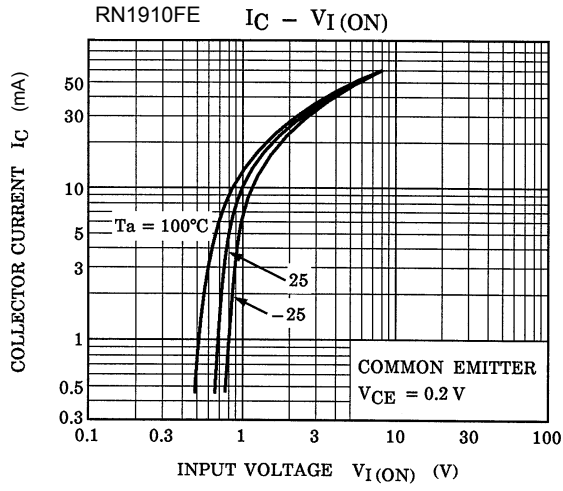
