### General Description

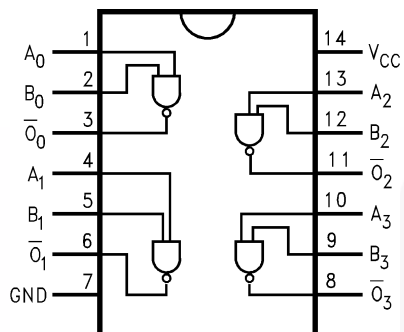

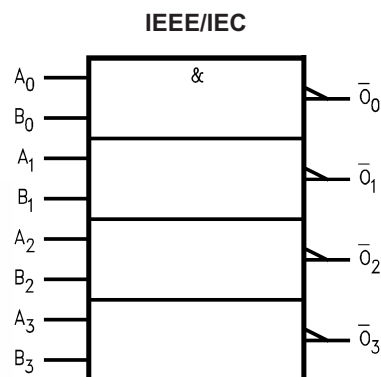

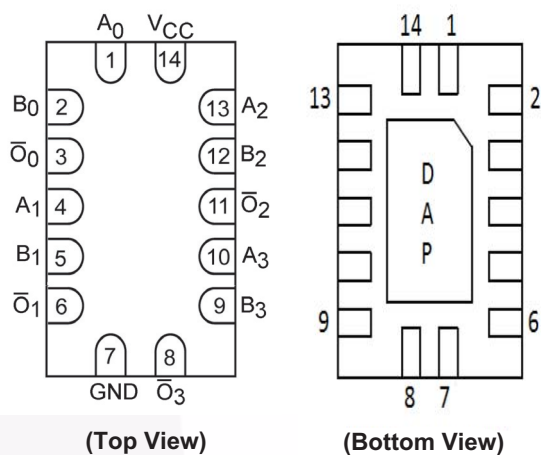
Pin Assignments for SOIC and TSSOP

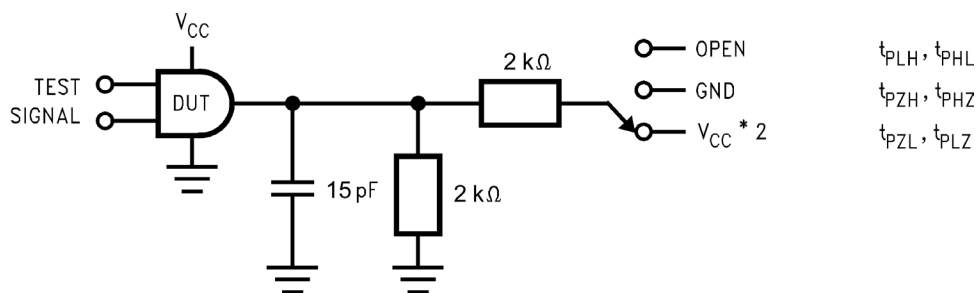

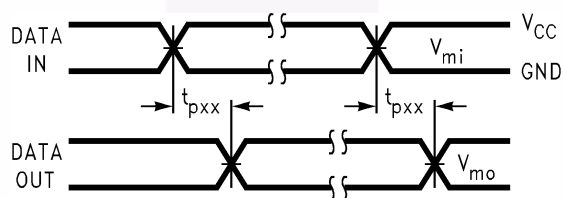
**Figure 2. Waveform for Inverting and Non-inverting Functions**

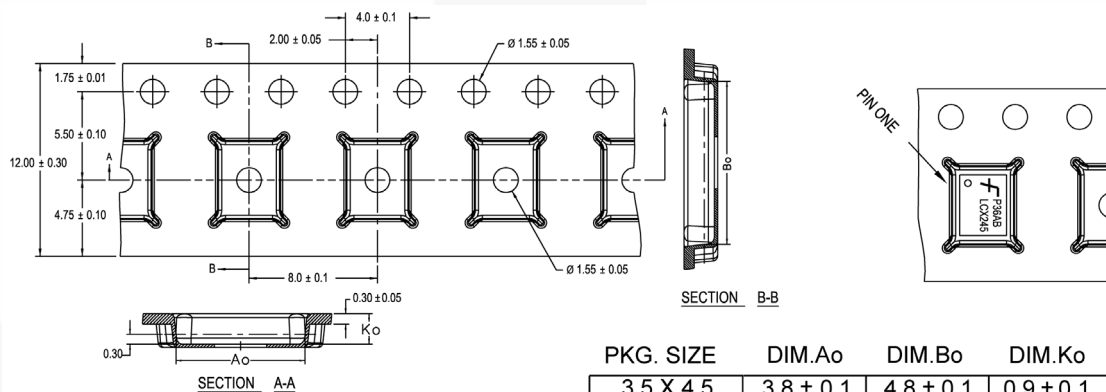
Figure 4. Waveform for Inverting and Non-Inverting Functions
